New Asia came before the Commission regarding the status of its All Forms Alcoholic Beverages 7 Day Restaurant license on April 26, 2010. The Licensing Commission was informed of the following:

1. You have (a) not taken any action relative to the reconstruction and re-opening of this restaurant, according to information obtained from the Inspectional Service Department, and (b) you have ceased to be engaged in the business you are licensed to pursue, in that you do not offer food and beverages, in accordance with G.L. c. 140, s.9 and (c) failed to operate the licensed premises on the days and at the location authorized under the license to serve alcoholic beverages in accordance with G.L. c 138, s. 77.
2. You are no longer on the City payment plan with the City Treasurer-Collector as to past due taxes. According to section 8-3 of the Somerville Code of Ordinances the City may revoke or suspend your license for non payment of taxes.
