Item #1 – Acceptance of Minutes from July 19, 2012 Traffic Commission Meeting

Item #2 – Request for Handicapped Parking:

18 Crescent St

35 Putnam St

14 Wesley St

Item #3 – Request for Fire Lane

- a) 570 Somerville Av at the Veterans Memorial Skating Rink Complex on the north side (rear) on both sides of the rear access road. Beginning at the entrance of the access road from the Bleachery Ct (west) side in an easterly direction extending approximately 220ft on the north side of the access road to a point at the east end of the zamboni garage. On the south side the fire lane will extend approximately 196ft in an easterly direction stopping at the point where the curb turns right to the zamboni dump area
- b) 570 Somerville Av at the Veterans Memorial Skating Rink Complex on the east side of the building extending the entire length
- c) 570 Somerville Av at the Veterans Memorial Skating Rink Complex on the east side of the access road adjacent to Conway Park. The fire lane shall begin on the north side at the end of the two handicapped spaces and extend to a point 22ft from the end of the rear parking lot on the south side
- d) Monmouth St on the north side beginning 10ft west of the hydrant at #23 Monmouth St continuing in a westerly direction to the intersection with Harvard St

Item #4 – Request for Bus Stop Relocation on Medford St from Broadway to Partridge Av:

- NWestbound reduce two bus stops to one, in a new location at the corner of Trull St on Medford St.
- SEastbound, reduce two bus stops to one, in a new location at the corner of Norwood Av on Medford St, across from Maher Studio

Item #5 - Request to extend the length of the existing Bus Stop on Highland Av at Walnut St (opposite the library) an additional 38ft for a total length of 80ft

Item #6 – Request to relocate the bus stop on Holland St at Davis Sq Station 20ft westerly (this will eliminate one metered parking space)

Item #7 – Request to allow MIT Saferide shuttle to utilize two MBTA bus stops located on Somerville Av at Prospect St and Somerville Av at the Shopping Plaza
