NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Committee on Legislative Matters, in concert with the Somerville Historic Preservation Commission, has scheduled a **public hearing on Tuesday, June 18, 2013 at 6:00 pm** in the Aldermanic Chambers, City Hall, 93 Highland Avenue, regarding a proposed map amendment to the Somerville Historic District Ordinance. The map amendment proposes to designate one additional property, 237 Washington Street, as a local historic district (LHD) in the City of Somerville. This property is more commonly known as the Union Square Post Office and is formally known as the Somerville Main Post Office.

Property owners and residents of the community are invited to this hearing. The purpose of this public hearing will be to answer questions and receive public comments regarding the proposed map amendment for 237 Washington Street. The Board of Aldermen will use these comments to reach a decision and vote on the proposed map amendment at a later date. A copy of the Somerville Main Post Office Draft Preliminary Report is available for review at www.somervillema.gov (see the Historic Preservation Commission webpage), the third floor of City Hall (93 Highland Avenue), and the Central Library (79 Highland Avenue).
