NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Committee on Legislative Matters, in concert with the Somerville Historic Preservation Commission, has scheduled a **public hearing on Monday, October 27, 2014 at 6:00 pm** in the Aldermanic Chambers, City Hall, 93 Highland Avenue, regarding proposed map amendments to the Somerville Historic District Ordinance. The map amendments propose to designate one additional property, 204 Morrison Avenue, to the Morrison Avenue Local Historic District (LHD) and to de-designate 72R Dane Street from the 72R Dane Street Local Historic District in the City of Somerville.

Property owners and residents of the community are invited to this hearing. The purpose of this public hearing will be to answer questions and receive public comments regarding the proposed map amendments for 204 Morrison Avenue and 72R Dane Street. The Board of Aldermen will use these comments to reach a decision and vote on the proposed map amendments at a later date. A copy of the Draft Preliminary Reports for each property is available for review at www.somervillema.gov (see the Historic Preservation Commission webpage), the third floor of City Hall (93 Highland Avenue), and the Central Library (79 Highland Avenue).
