Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 138 §34 – Sales, delivery or furnishing alcoholic beverages to a person under twenty-one years of age

Somerville Licensing Commission Rule 1.08i – Whoever makes a sale or delivery of any alcoholic beverages or alcohol to any person under twenty-one years of age, either for his own use or for the use of his parent or any other person, or whoever, being a patron of an establishment licensed under section 12 or 15 of General Laws Chapter 138 delivers or procures to be delivered in any public room or area of such establishment any such beverages or alcohol to or for use of a person who he knows or has reason to believe to be under twenty-one years of age or whoever procures any such beverages or alcohol for a person under twenty-one years of age in any establishment licensed under section 12, or procures any such beverage or alcohol for a person under twenty-one years of age who is not his child, ward or spouse in any establishment that is a package store, shall be subject to disciplinary action by the Licensing Commission.

The date of the alleged offense is July 11, 2007 at 7:00 p.m. as reported to this office by Somerville Police Inspector Warren Chaille.

7. International Soccer Club, Inc., 5 Marshall Street to show cause why its Common Victualer license should not be suspended or revoked for alleged violation of MGL Chapter 140 Section 9 to wit:

**MGL C138, §61** - All buildings or places used by clubs for the purpose of selling, distributing or dispensing alcoholic beverages to their members or others shall be deemed common nuisances unless duly licensed under this chapter. Whoever keeps or maintains, or assists in keeping or maintaining, such a common nuisance shall be punished by a fine of not less than fifty nor more than five hundred dollars or by imprisonment for not less than three months nor more than one year, or both.

**Somerville Licensing Commission Rule 2.02. a** - Patrons are not permitted to bring alcoholic beverages on the premises for their own consumption. Licensees are not permitted to keep alcoholic beverages on the premises except for a reasonably small quantity that is used in the preparation of certain specialty foods. The Commission will, in its discretion, determine what is reasonable for this purpose and whether it is customary in the preparation of such specialty foods.
