3. B.E.E.F., Inc. d/b/a Café Abyssinia requesting approval to alter the licensed premises by adding a street level kitchen approximately 13' x 8' and adding a 20' window counter on the premises situated at 145-147 Broadway

4. Blue Sky Grille, LLC d/b/a Blue Sky Grille requesting approval to transfer its All Forms Alcoholic Beverages 7-Day Restaurant license to Samba Enterprises, LLC, Maria Assunta Scofield, Manager on the premises situated at 596-598 Somerville Avenue, consisting of two rooms on street level with two bathrooms and a utility kitchen; a basement containing a functional kitchen, dry and cold storage, office, dressing room and bathroom. Also being requested is approval of an Entertainment license for four televisions, radio/cd/stereo, disc jockey, live musical and vocal entertainers and a Dance license for dancing by patrons.

**5. SUNDAY SALES BY HOLDERS OF LICENSES UNDER G.L. C. 138 ' 15
PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 141 OF THE ACTS OF 2003**

The Commission will be considering the following:

1. Issuance of Sunday Permits with the following conditions:
 - i. no sales may be made prior to noon;
 - ii. no sales may be made after 11:00 p.m.; no sales may be made after 11:30 p.m. on a Sunday that immediately precedes a legal holiday;
 - iii. employees must be paid at a rate of not less than 1 ½ of the employee's regular rate;
 - iv. any §15 licensee that sells on Sundays and employs more than seven persons must compensate all employees working on Sunday at a rate not less than 1 ½ of the employees regular rate;
 - v. no employee may be required to work on a Sunday; refusal to work on a Sunday is not grounds for discrimination, dismissal, discharge, deduction of hours, or any other penalty.

No sales may be permitted on:

- i. the last Monday in May (Memorial Day);
 - ii. Thanksgiving Day
 - iii. Christmas Day, or on the day following when Christmas day falls on a Sunday;
 - iv. Sunday Christmas Day, if Christmas Day falls on a Sunday.
2. Permitting sales by a §15 licensee on 6 days per week or 7 days per week basis
 - i. If the Licensing Commission permits a §15 licensee to sell on Sunday, the Commission must allow a licensee to close on one other day of the week, without any risk or threat of canceling the license for failure to conduct the license business pursuant to G.L. c 138 s 77.
 - ii. If the Licensing Commission permits a §15 licensee to sell on just 6 days per week, the Commission in its discretion may also choose which day of the week the §15 licensee must close.
