1. Placement of privately-funded monument to Donald Curtin in Hodgkins-Curtin Park. **Approved (unanimous).** The Commission voted solely to approve the establishment of such a monument. Since the monument will be privately designed, created, and funded, and since the monument will be placed in property under the jurisdiction of the Parks Department, the petitioner must assume responsibility for the acquisition of permits, construction of a footing, seeking approval for an appropriate location of the monument within the park, maintenance, and all other issues relating to the establishment of this monument.
2. Dedication of square to Edward Reed. **Approved (unanimous).** Location to be determined.
3. Dedication of a square to the Mitchell brothers. **Approved (unanimous).** Due to the large number of veterans to be honored in this dedication, the sign will read "Mitchell Brothers Square," and will not bear the individual names of each honoree.
4. Dedication of a square to the Murphy brothers. **Approved (unanimous).**
5. Dedication of a square to Martin Shaugnessey. **Approved (unanimous).**
6. Dedication of a square to James Trant. **Approved (unanimous).**
7. Dedication of a square to Edward Reddin. **Approved (unanimous).**
8. Dedication of a square to Vincent Fontano. **Approved (unanimous).**
9. Dedication of a square to Ray Scalese. **Approved (unanimous).**



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10. Dedication of a square to William B. Ward, Jr. **Approved (unanimous).**

11. Dedication of a square to Carl E. Johansen, Jr. **Approved (unanimous).**
