**REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE**  
**ON LICENSES AND PERMITS**

The Committee on Licenses and Permits convened on March 21, 2007, with Chairman Bruce Desmond presiding and Committee Members Aldermen Maryann Heuston and Robert Trane also present and voting. Also present were George Landers from ISD, Frank Senesi from Veterans Services, Michele Lawlor (representing Dunkin Donuts) and John Correira.

The committee held a public hearing on the petition of Dunkin Donuts for an extended hours permit. There were no speakers for nor against the petition. Due to the fact that no representative of the petitioner was present, the committee voted to deny the petition. After that vote, a representative of Dunkin Donuts arrived at the meeting. In an effort to be fair, the committee voted for reconsideration and heard from the representative, Michele Lawlor, who explained that the business has been operating as a 24 hours business for over 30 years. The committee voted to approve the petition.

An order by Aldermen Desmond, Heuston and Trane **that the City Solicitor and the City Clerk provide the committee with a written explanation of their responsibilities and authority in issuing a license on an existing license that falls under a victualer's license, and to distinguish the committee's responsibility as it relates to approving and issuing licenses in those places**, was approved.
