Item #1 – Minutes from March 21, 2013 and March 27, 2013 Traffic Commission Meeting accepted unanimously.

Item #2 – Request for Handicapped Parking:

17 Cutter St

Smith stated that T&P had no objections. Motion to Approve made by Graney, 2<sup>nd</sup> Sheehan, unanimous.

Trane asked to hold 17 Russell Rd until the May meeting due to a conflict of interest; Motion to Approve all except 17 Russell Rd made by Graney, 2<sup>nd</sup> Trane, unanimous.

Item #4 – Request for Turning Restrictions onto Cherry St from Summer St (7am-9am, Mon-Fri, except residents).

Smith explained that this was implemented in September due to complaints of vehicles using Cherry St to access the Kennedy School and due to an oversight was not brought before the Traffic Commission for approval. Motion to Approve was made by Trane, 2<sup>nd</sup> Graney, unanimous.

Item #5 – Request to alter the intersection of Elmwood St @ Tannery Brook Row to a four (4) way stop control in all directions.

Smith explained that the intersection does not meet the criteria of the MUTCD and therefore T&P does not support the request. Trane stated he will speak to the property management company and ask them to put out rubber speed bumps. He requested that T&P review the original plan for the building. Motion to Deny made by Graney, 2<sup>nd</sup> Sheehan, unanimous.

Item #6 – Prior Business

a) Request for Handicapped Parking 34 Linden St.

Smith explained this is still under review and requested Tabling the item for another month. Motion to Table made by Graney, 2<sup>nd</sup> Trane, unanimous.
