**Item #2-** To further Amend Article XI, "Penalties and Repeals", Section 11-2, "Penalties", by inserting the following language at the end of the existing language:

Invalid or expired registration plate                      \$50\*

Invalid or expired certificate of inspection              \$50\*

\*No fine shall be issued until 72 hours after the expiration of the vehicle inspection sticker.
